Ulf Fredriksson is Associate Professor and works as teacher and researcher at the Department of Education, Stockholm University. He is a trained primary teacher as well as a secondary teacher of civics and history. He has a Ph.D. in International and Comparative Education. He has earlier worked in schools in Sweden, for the Swedish teacher union, at the headquarters of Education International in Brussels, Belgium, at the Joint Research Centre (JRC) of the European Commission in Ispra, Italy and at Mid Sweden University. From 2008 to 2016 he was responsible for the reading comprehension part of the PISA studies in Sweden. He has been appointed to be part of government investigations on how to provide support to students with weak skills in reading, writing and mathematics and how to stimulate the interest for reading among school students. His research has focused on international and comparative education, reading instruction, students of immigrant background, learning to learn, the use of ICT in schools and teachers.
